

SENATE BILL No. 7

February 5, 1991, Introduced by Senator WELBORN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"The code of criminal procedure,"

as amended, being sections 764.1 to 764.29 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 15e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter IV of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of
2 1927, as amended, being sections 764.1 to 764.29 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 15e to read as
4 follows:

6 SEC. 15E. A PEACE OFFICER WHO HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO
7 BELIEVE THAT A VIOLATION OF SECTION 136B OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL
8 CODE, ACT NO. 328 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1931, BEING SECTION
9 750.136B OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, HAS TAKEN PLACE OR IS

1 TAKING PLACE, MAY ARREST THE VIOLATOR WITHOUT A WARRANT FOR THAT
2 VIOLATION, IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER THE VIOLATION WAS COMMITTED IN
3 THE PEACE OFFICER'S PRESENCE.
