February 5, 1991, Introduced by Senator BARCIA and referred to the Committee on State Affairs and Military/Veteran Affairs.

A bill to amend section 721 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled as amended

"Michigan vehicle code,"

as amended by Act No. 75 of the Public Acts of 1990, being section 257.721 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 721 of Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1949, as amended by Act No. 75 of the Public Acts of 1990, being
- 3 section 257.721 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 Sec. 721. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 6 (5), a passenger vehicle or a pickup truck shall not be driven
- 7 upon a highway drawing or having attached to the passenger
- 8 vehicle or pickup truck more than 1 vehicle or trailer.

- 1 (2) The drawbar or other connection between 2 vehicles, 1 of
- 2 which is towing or drawing the other on a highway, shall not
- 3 exceed 15 feet in length from 1 vehicle to the other. If the
- 4 connection consists of a chain, rope, or cable, there shall be
- 5 displayed upon the connection a red flag or other signal or cloth
- 6 not less than 12 inches both in length and width.
- 7 (3) A vehicle or trailer towed or drawn by a vehicle shall
- 8 be attached to the vehicle with forms of coupling devices in a
- 9 manner so that when the combination is operated in a linear
- 10 alignment on a level, smooth, paved surface, the movement of the
- 11 towed or drawn vehicle or trailer does not deviate more than
- 12 3 inches to either side of the path of the towing vehicle that
- 13 tows or draws it. The vehicle or trailer shall also be connected
- 14 to the towing vehicle, by suitable safety chains or devices, 1 on
- 15 each side of the coupling -and at the extreme outer edge of the
- 16 vehicle or trailer and each chain or device and connection used
- 17 shall be of sufficient strength to haul the vehicle or trailer
- 18 when loaded.
- 19 (4) A pickup truck with a fifth wheel assembly shall not tow
- 20 a semitrailer unless the fifth wheel assembly conforms to motor
- 21 carrier safety rule R 460.16442 of the Michigan administrative
- 22 code.
- 23 (5) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a pickup truck with a
- 24 towing rating equal to, or greater than, the weight being towed,
- 25 equipped with a fifth wheel assembly which conforms with motor
- 26 carrier safety rules promulgated by the department of state
- 27 police pursuant to the motor carrier safety act of 1963, Act

- 1 No. 181 of the Public Acts of 1963, being sections 480.11 to
- 2 480.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, towing attached with a
- 3 semitrailer designed for recreational living purposes may tow an
- 4 additional trailer or semitrailer under ANY OF the following
- 5 conditions:
- 6 (a) The additional trailer or semitrailer shall be attached
- 7 pursuant to subsection (3). The safety chains described in
- 8 subsection (3) shall be securely attached -at the extreme outer
- 9 edge of the attached TO THE trailer or semitrailer with a lock-
- 10 ing mechanism. The towing vehicle hitch shall be of substantial
- 11 material and shall be attached in a proper and skillful manner to
- 12 the frame of the towing vehicle.
- (b) The total length of the pickup truck, semitrailer
- 14 designed for recreational living purposes, and additional trailer
- 15 or semitrailer shall not exceed -59-65 feet.
- 16 (c) The gross weight of the additional trailer or semi-
- 17 trailer towed or drawn shall not exceed the empty weight of the
- 18 pickup truck or the empty weight of the semitrailer.
- 19 (6) For the purposes of this section, a pickup truck towing
- 20 a semitrailer and additional trailer shall be considered a pas-
- 21 senger vehicle and shall comply with the speed limit requirements
- 22 of section 627(5).
- (7) The office of highway safety and planning shall compile
- 24 a study and report to the legislature within 2 years after -the
- 25 effective date of the amendatory act that added this subsection-
- 26 MAY 17, 1990, with respect to the effect on highway safety of the
- 27 changes made in towing requirements for pickup trucks with fifth

- 1 wheel assemblies and additional trailers by the amendatory act
- 2 that added this subsection.
- 3 (8) A person who violates this section is responsible for a
- 4 civil infraction.
