SENATE BILL No. 110

February 19, 1991, Introduced by Senators DE GROW, CONROY, KOIVISTO, CHERRY and BERRYMAN and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Reapportionment.

A bill to amend the title and sections 4 and 10 of Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1941, entitled as amended

"An act for the purpose of controlling and eradicating certain noxious weeds within the state, to permit townships, villages and cities to have a lien for expenses incurred in controlling and eradicating such weeds, to permit officials of counties and municipalities to appoint commissioners of noxious weeds, to define their powers, duties and compensation, and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

section 4 as amended by Act No. 58 of the Public Acts of 1984 and section 10 as amended by Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 247.64 and 247.70 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title and sections 4 and 10 of Act No. 359
- 2 of the Public Acts of 1941, section 4 as amended by Act No. 58 of
- 3 the Public Acts of 1984 and section 10 as amended by Act No. 218
- 4 of the Public Acts of 1990, being sections 247.64 and 247.70 of
- 5 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

- 10 Sec. 4. (1) The owner of land on which noxious weeds are
- 11 found growing shall destroy the weeds before they reach a seed
- 12 bearing stage and prevent their regrowth, or shall prevent them
- 13 from becoming a detriment to public health. The commissioner
- 14 shall notify by certified mail with return receipt requested —
- 15 the owner, agent, or occupant of -any-land on which noxious
- 16 weeds are found growing. The notice shall describe methods of
- 17 treating and eradicating the noxious weeds and a summary of the
- 18 provisions of this section. Failure of the commissioner to give
- 19 such notice -shall- DOES not, however, constitute a defense to
- 20 -any- AN action to enforce the payment of -any penalty- A FINE
- 21 provided for or debt created under this act. If the owner,
- 22 agent, or occupant refuses to destroy the noxious weeds, -or
- 23 cause them to be destroyed, the commissioner shall enter upon
- 24 the land and destroy the noxious weeds. or cause them to be
- 25 destroyed. Any expense EXPENSES incurred in the destruction
- 26 shall be paid by the owner -or owners of the land, and the
- 27 township, city, or village of which the commissioner is an

- 1 officer shall have a lien against the land for the amount of the
- 2 expense, which lien shall be enforced in the manner -now pro-
- 3 vided by law for the enforcement of -mechanics CONSTRUCTION
- 4 liens.
- 5 (2) -Any A village or city, or -any A township having a
- 6 population of more than 5,000, may, whether or not provided in
- 7 its charter, provide by ordinance enacted for the purpose of con-
- 8 trolling and eradicating noxious weeds in subdivided land --
- 9 that if the owner, agent, or occupant of -any subdivided land in
- 10 -any A subdivision in which buildings have been erected on 60%
- 11 of the lots, -included in that subdivision, or the -owners,
- 12 agents, or occupants of lots OWNER, AGENT, OR OCCUPANT OF A LOT
- 13 along -all AN improved -streets- STREET in common usage, for a
- 14 depth of 10 rods or the depth of the -lots LOT, whichever is
- 15 -the lesser LESS, has failed, after 10 days' notice as provided
- 16 in this section, to destroy the weeds, -or cause them to be
- 17 destroyed, then any official, inspector, or other THEN AN agent
- 18 authorized by the governing body of the township, village, or
- 19 city may enter upon the subdivided land or lots and destroy
- 20 NOXIOUS WEEDS by cutting. -, with or without mechanical equip-
- 21 ment which MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT THAT will not damage the prop-
- 22 erty or the adjacent sidewalk, -any MAY BE USED TO CUT THE nox-
- 23 ious weeds. Any expense EXPENSES incurred in the destruction
- 24 shall be paid by the owner -or owners- of the subdivided land.
- 25 The township, village, or city shall have a lien upon the subdi-
- 26 vided land or lots for the amount of the expense. -, the THE
- 27 lien -to- SHALL be enforced in the manner prescribed by charter,

- 1 by the laws of the state providing for the enforcement of tax
- 2 liens, or by ordinance duly passed by the governing body of the
- 3 township, village, or city.
- 4 (3) Any AN owner who refuses to destroy noxious weeds as
- 5 provided for in this section -shall be IS subject to a fine of
- 6 not more than \$100.00, -which fine THAT when collected, shall
- 7 become a part of the "noxious weed control fund" of the township,
- 8 village, or city.
- 9 (4) This act -shall DOES not apply to weeds in fields
- 10 devoted to growing any small grain crop such as wheat, oats,
- 11 barley, or rye. In the case of AN easement, property such as AN
- 12 abandoned -subdivisions SUBDIVISION, strip -mines, and MINE, OR
- 13 gravel -pits- PIT, public property such as A forest -preserves-
- 14 PRESERVE, and all other land as to which definite ownership is
- 15 not known to the commissioner and cannot be established, the
- 16 county board of commissioners shall cause the destruction of nox-
- 17 ious weeds in accordance with this act.
- 18 (5) If the county board of commissioners of -any A county
- 19 -of this state passes a resolution to participate under the pro-
- 20 visions of this act, the commissioner of noxious weeds shall
- 21 notify the department of natural resources, which shall determine
- 22 whether there is land in the county belonging to -the- THIS state
- 23 -of Michigan under the jurisdiction of the department. The
- 24 department of natural resources shall cut -all noxious weeds
- 25 growing on -any THAT land -under its jurisdiction within 10
- 26 rods of any privately owned improved property, upon receipt of
- 27 the notification. If the department of natural resources fails

- 1 to cut the weeds, the commissioner of noxious weeds shall enter
- 2 upon the land and destroy the weeds. -or cause them to be
- 3 destroyed, the THE expense of which shall be a charge against
- 4 the department of natural resources and may be recovered in
- 5 an action in the court of claims.
- 6 Sec. 10. The boards COUNTY BOARD of commissioners may
- 7 make -appropriations AN APPROPRIATION from the county treasury
- 8 to aid in destroying the noxious weeds in -any 1 or more towns or
- 9 precincts A TOWN OR PRECINCT of the county. -; and in case they
- 10 deem it expedient, they THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS may assume
- 11 control over any 1 tract or of all the noxious weeds in ALL OR
- 12 PART OF the county, -and- MAY make -such- NOXIOUS WEED provisions
- 13 as they may deem THAT IT CONSIDERS necessary, and MAY impose
- 14 -penalties A FINE, not exceeding \$100.00 for each -offense, for
- 15 a violation of any SUCH A provision. made by them on this
- 16 subject, to be sued for, THE ACTION FOR IMPOSITION OF THE FINE
- 17 SHALL BE COMMENCED in the name and for the use of the proper
- 18 county, before the district or municipal court of the judicial
- 19 district or municipality in which the weeds are located.
- 20 -Whenever IF the board of commissioners -shall decide to assume
- 21 ASSUMES control, -and-so long as they exercise it, their ITS
- 22 jurisdiction -shall be IS superior to that of the commissioner
- 23 OF NOXIOUS WEEDS SO LONG AS THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS EXERCISES
- 24 THAT CONTROL.
- 25 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 26 Senate Bill No. 96
- of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.

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
