## SENATE BILL No. 153

March 7, 1991, Introduced by Senators EHLERS, GAST and POLLACK and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of natural resources and for capital outlay purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1991; to provide for certain work projects; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

12	this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and
13	programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to
14	the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984,
15	being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
16	Sec. 203. For all projects and grant programs funded under this
17	act, the commission of natural resources or the department of natural
18	resources shall notify each legislator whose district is to receive a
19	grant 7 days before the grant is announced.

## 20 CAPITAL OUTLAY

Sec. 301. The unexpended portion of the appropriation in section 22 101 for wildlife management recreation bond projects shall be considered 23 a work project and shall not lapse to the recreation bond fund but shall 24 continue to be available for the purpose for which it was appropriated.
