

SENATE BILL No. 163

March 12, 1991, Introduced by Senators DUNASKISS, BARCIA, EMMONS and POSTHUMUS and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend section 502b of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
being section 750.502b of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 502b of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts
2 of 1931, being section 750.502b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 502b. ~~Any~~ A person who ~~shall~~ knowingly ~~sell or~~
5 ~~attempt~~ SELLS OR ATTEMPTS to sell to any person in this state,
6 for use in atmospheric pressure wick-feed illuminating apparatus
7 or atmospheric pressure wick-feed heating stoves or in
8 gravity-feed cook stoves, any kerosene, whether manufactured in
9 this state or not, ~~which shall have~~ THAT HAS a flash point of
10 less than ~~121~~ 100 degrees Fahrenheit as determined by the

2 misdemeanor, ~~and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a~~
3 ~~fine of not exceeding \$300.00, or to imprisonment in the county~~

5 THAN 6 months OR BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$300.00, or ~~to~~
