## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 502b of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1931, being section 750.502b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 502b. -Any A person who -shall knowingly -sell or
- 5 attempt SELLS OR ATTEMPTS to sell to any person in this state,
- 6 for use in atmospheric pressure wick-feed illuminating apparatus
- 7 or atmospheric pressure wick-feed heating stoves or in
- 8 gravity-feed cook stoves, any kerosene, whether manufactured in
- 9 this state or not, -which shall have THAT HAS a flash point of
- 10 less than -121 100 degrees Fahrenheit as determined by the

- 1 Tagliabue closed cup tester, -shall be IS guilty of a
- 2 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a
- 3 fine of not exceeding \$300.00, or to imprisonment in the county
- 4 jail for not to exceed PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
- 5 THAN 6 months OR BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$300.00, or -to-
- 6 both. such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the
