

SENATE BILL No. 166

March 13, 1991, Introduced by Senators GAST, ARTHURHULTZ
and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations to the department of natural resources; to provide for the acquisition of land; to provide for the development of public recreation facilities; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to provide for the expenditure of appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. There is appropriated for the department of natural
2 resources to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 1991, the sum of \$17,850,000.00 for land
4 acquisition and grants and \$5,950,000.00 for public recreation
5 facility development and grants as provided in section 35 of
6 article IX of the state constitution of 1963 and the Michigan
7 natural resources trust fund act, Act No. 101 of the Public Acts
8 of 1985, being sections 318.501 to 318.516 of the Michigan
9 Compiled Laws, from the following funds:

2 Sec. 3. The department of natural resources shall enter
3 into agreements with local units of government for the purpose of
4 administering the grants identified in section 1. The agreements
5 shall require that grant recipients do all of the following:

6 (a) Dedicate to public recreation uses in perpetuity the
7 lands acquired.

8 (b) Replace lands converted or lost to other than public
9 recreation use.

10 (c) Convey to the state any mineral interests acquired by
11 the grant recipient with an exception allowed for a share of the
12 mineral interests acquired, which share is based on the portion
13 of the fair market value of the property that was provided by the
14 local cash contribution of the grant recipient.

15 (d) Make full payments of grants only after proof of acqui-
16 sition is submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are ver-
17 ified by the department of natural resources.

18 (e) Comply with any other requirement of the department of
19 natural resources.

20 Sec. 4. The department of natural resources shall take
21 steps necessary to make available federal or other funds that may
22 become available for the purpose for which appropriations are
23 made in section 1, and to use any or all of the appropriations to
24 meet matching requirements that are determined by the department
25 to be in the best interest of the state.

26 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance in any appropriation made
27 under section 1 shall not revert to the fund from which

1 appropriated at the close of the fiscal year, but shall continue
2 until the purpose for which it was appropriated is completed.
3 The unexpended balance of any appropriation made in section 1
4 remaining after the purpose for which it was appropriated is com-
5 pleted shall revert to the Michigan natural resources trust fund
6 and be made available for appropriation.

7 Sec. 6. If a person or organization has acquired an option
8 on a parcel of property prior to final determination by the
9 department of natural resources and the Michigan natural
10 resources trust fund board, the property shall not be considered
11 for acquisition unless the department and the Michigan natural
12 resources trust fund board demonstrate that a clear recreational
13 advantage exists in obtaining the parcel of property for the
14 people of the state at a reasonable fair market value.

15 Sec. 7. Grants-in-aid to local units of government shall be
16 awarded pursuant to this act.

17 Sec. 8. The appropriation in section 1 (priority no. 15)
18 for various public access sites land acquisition (#89-174) shall
19 not be expended for land acquisition on a lake not specifically
20 identified.
