

SENATE BILL No. 167

March 13, 1991, Introduced by Senator MC MANUS and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Reapportionment.

A bill to divide this state into 18 congressional districts, 38 senatorial districts, and 110 representative districts; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This state is divided into 18 congressional dis-
2 tricts pursuant to the ratio of representation fixed under an act
3 of congress for the apportionment of the representatives among
4 the several states. Each district is entitled to 1
5 representative. The districts are constituted and numbered as

13 Sec. 4. The secretary of state shall prepare a map and a
14 legal description of each district constituted under this act.
15 The legal description shall be in terms of political subdivi-
16 sions, such as counties, cities, and townships; man-made fea-
17 tures, such as streets, roads, highways, and railroads; and natu-
18 ral features, such as waterways, which political subdivisions and
19 man-made and natural features form the boundaries of the
20 district. The secretary of state shall convey the map and legal
21 description of each district to the legislature and the
22 governor.

23 Sec. 5. As used in this act:

24 (a) "Block" means block as that term is used by the United
25 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
26 the 1990 decennial census.

1 (b) "ED" means enumeration district as that term is used by
2 the United States department of commerce, bureau of the census in
3 conducting the 1990 decennial census.

4 (c) "Tract" means tract as that term is used by the United
5 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
6 the 1990 decennial census.

7 Sec. 6. Act No. 282 of the Public Acts of 1964, being
8 sections 3.51 to 3.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
9 repealed.
