SENATE BILL No. 270

April 16, 1991, Introduced by Senators CHERRY, O'BRIEN, HART, GEAKE and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend the title and section 6 of Act No. 101 of the Public Acts of 1985, entitled

"Michigan natural resources trust fund act,"

being section 318.506 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 6a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and section 6 of Act No. 101 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1985, being section 318.506 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended and section 6a is added to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 TITLE
- 6 An act to provide for the implementation of section 35 of
- 7 article IX of the state constitution of 1963 creating the
- 8 Michigan natural resources trust fund; TO ESTABLISH THE NATURAL
- 9 HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND; to establish the Michigan natural

- 1 resources trust fund board; to establish the Michigan natural
- 2 resources trust bondholder protection board; to require the
- 3 transfer of money from certain trusts to the Michigan natural
- 4 resources trust fund; to require the transfer of certain docu-
- 5 ments and records; to prescribe certain powers and duties of the
- 6 Michigan natural resources trust fund board, the Michigan natural
- 7 resources trust bondholder protection board, the state treasurer,
- 8 the department of natural resources, and the department of trea-
- 9 sury; to provide for certain distributions from the Michigan nat-
- 10 ural resources trust fund AND THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST
- 11 FUND, and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.
- 12 Sec. 6. The amount accumulated in the trust fund shall not
- 13 exceed $-\frac{$200,000,000.00}{$400,000,000.00}$, exclusive of interest
- 14 and earnings. Any amount of money that would be a part of the
- 15 trust fund but for the limitation stated in this section FOR THE
- 16 TRUST FUND shall be deposited -as provided by law INTO THE NATU-
- 17 RAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 6A UNTIL
- 18 THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND REACHES ITS ACCUMULATION
- 19 LIMIT OF \$100,000,000.00. AFTER THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH
- 20 TRUST FUND HAS REACHED ITS ACCUMULATION LIMIT, MONEY RECEIVED
- 21 SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND. However, only the bal-
- 22 ance remaining after the operation of section 5(1) and (2) shall
- 23 be subject to this section.
- 24 SEC. 6A. (1) THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND IS
- 25 ESTABLISHED IN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 26 DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST
- 27 FUND. INTEREST AND EARNINGS OF THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH

- 1 TRUST FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH
- 2 TRUST FUND. MONEY IN THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND AT
- 3 THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE NATURAL HERITAGE
- 4 RESEARCH TRUST FUND AND SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 5 (2) THE AMOUNT ACCUMULATED IN THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH
- 6 TRUST FUND IN ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR SHALL NOT EXCEED
- 7 \$100,000,000.00, EXCLUSIVE OF INTEREST AND EARNINGS. PRIOR TO
- 8 REACHING THIS LIMIT, NOT MORE THAN 33-1/3% OF THE MONEY, EXCLU-
- 9 SIVE OF INTEREST AND EARNINGS, RECEIVED BY THE NATURAL HERITAGE
- 10 RESEARCH TRUST FUND IN ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR MAY BE EXPENDED IN
- 11 THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR FOR THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN
- 12 SUBSECTION (3). AFTER THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND
- 13 REACHES THIS LIMIT, ONLY THE INTEREST AND EARNINGS OF THE NATURAL
- 14 HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND MAY BE EXPENDED AND ONLY FOR THE
- 15 PURPOSES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (3).
- 16 (3) MONEY IN THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND SHALL
- 17 BE USED BY THE DEPARTMENT, UPON APPROPRIATION, FOR GRANTS FOR
- 18 RESEARCH AND PILOT PROJECTS INTENDED TO MAINTAIN OR ENHANCE THE
- 19 STATE'S BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY, RESEARCH AND PILOT PROJECTS CON-
- 20 TRIBUTING TO THE SUSTAINED VIABILITY OF PLANT, ANIMAL, OR GREAT
- 21 LAKES FISH POPULATIONS, RESEARCH AND PILOT PROJECTS FOR HABITAT
- 22 MAINTENANCE AND RESTORATION, AND RESEARCH AND PILOT PROJECTS FOR
- 23 FISH AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT, AND FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATU-
- 24 RAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (4).
- 25 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A LONG-TERM RESEARCH PRO-
- 26 GRAM FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST
- 27 FUND, AND SHALL UPDATE IT ANNUALLY. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ACCEPT

- 1 APPLICATIONS, DETERMINE WHICH PROJECTS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE
- 2 LONG-TERM RESEARCH PROGRAM, AND RECOMMEND TO THE COMMISSION ON
- 3 NATURAL RESOURCES WHICH PROJECTS SHOULD BE FUNDED FROM THE NATU-
- 4 RAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND. UPON APPROVAL OF THE COMMIS-
- 5 SION ON NATURAL RESOURCES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
- 6 LEGISLATURE IN JANUARY OF EACH YEAR A LIST OF THOSE PROJECTS THAT
- 7 THE COMMISSION OF NATURAL RESOURCES HAS DETERMINED SHOULD BE
- 8 FUNDED BY THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH TRUST FUND. THE DEPART-
- 9 MENT SHALL PROVIDE THE LEGISLATURE WITH A STATEMENT OF THE GUIDE-
- 10 LINES USED IN PREPARING THE LIST OF PROJECTS.
- 11 (5) THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ANNUALLY APPROVE BY LAW THE
- 12 PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED WITH MONEY IN THE NATURAL HERITAGE RESEARCH
- 13 TRUST FUND.
