A bill to provide for the determination of death; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "uniform determination of death act".
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) An individual who has sustained either of the
- 4 following is dead:
- 5 (a) Irreversible cessation of circulatory and respiratory
- 6 functions.
- 7 (b) Irreversible cessation of all functions of the entire
- 8 brain, including the brain stem.
- 9 (2) A determination of death shall be made in accordance
- 10 with accepted medical standards.

- 1 Sec. 3. This act shall be applied and construed to
- 2 effectuate its general purpose and to make uniform the law with
- 3 respect to the subject of this act among states enacting it.
- 4 Sec. 4. Act No. 124 of the Public Acts of 1979, being sec-
- 5 tions 333.1021 to 333.1024 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 6 repealed.
