

# SENATE BILL No. 430

July 11, 1991, Introduced by Senators DILLINGHAM, EMMONS, CISKY, DE GROW, EHLERS, GEAKE, CARL, DUNASKISS, MC MANUS, WARTNER, PRIDNIA and ARTHURHULTZ and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended

"The social welfare act,"

as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 107a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as  
2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 107a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 107A. A FAMILY RECEIVING AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT  
5 CHILDREN IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR A  
6 PERIOD OF 1 YEAR AFTER THE FAMILY BECOMES INELIGIBLE FOR AID TO  
7 FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN BECAUSE OF THE LOSS OF, OR  
8 INCOME FROM, EMPLOYMENT OF THE RELATIVE DESCRIBED IN SECTION  
9 56(1)(B). THE AMOUNT, DURATION, AND SCOPE OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

- 1 DURING THE 1-YEAR PERIOD SHALL BE THE SAME AS IF THE FAMILY WERE
- 2 STILL RECEIVING AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN.
