A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939,
entitled as amended
"The social welfare act,"
as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 55d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.121 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 55d to read as follows:
4 SEC. 55D. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE GENERAL ASSISTANCE
5 MEDICAL BENEFITS TO A PERSON FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR AFTER THE
6 PERSON BECOMES INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE GENERAL ASSISTANCE BECAUSE
7 OF THE HOURS OF, OR INCOME FROM, EMPLOYMENT. THE AMOUNT,
8 DURATION, AND SCOPE OF MEDICAL BENEFITS DURING THE 1-YEAR PERIOD

1 SHALL BE THE SAME AS IF THE PERSON WERE STILL RECEIVING GENERAL
2 ASSISTANCE.
