A bill to amend Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1893,
entitled as amended

"The general property tax act,"

as amended, being sections 211.1 to 211.157 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 30c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1893, as
2 amended, being sections 211.1 to 211.157 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 30c to read as follows:

4 SEC. 30C. IF A TAXPAYER HAS THE ASSESSMENT REDUCED ON HIS
5 OR HER PROPERTY AS A RESULT OF A PROTEST TO THE BOARD OF REVIEW
6 UNDER SECTION 30, THE ASSESSOR SHALL USE THAT REDUCED AMOUNT AS
7 THE BASIS FOR CALCULATING THE ASSESSMENT IN THE IMMEDIATELY
8 SUCCEEDING YEAR.
