- 6 PERSON'S PRESENCE, A MOTOR VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN SECTION 412
- 7 WHILE ARMED WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON, OR AN ARTICLE USED OR
- 8 FASHIONED IN A MANNER TO LEAD THE PERSON ASSAULTED REASONABLY TO
- 9 BELIEVE IT IS A DANGEROUS WEAPON, IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND SHALL

- 1 BE PUNISHED BY IMPRISONMENT FOR LIFE, OR FOR ANY TERM OF YEARS
- 2 BUT NOT LESS THAN 10 YEARS.
