THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) In redistricting the house of representatives
- 2 and the senate, the legislature shall comply with section 2 of
- 3 title I of the voting rights act of 1965, Public Law 89-110, 42
- 4 U.S.C. 1973, by adhering to the standards of subsection (2).
- 5 (2) Any county, city, or township line shall be broken to
- 6 permit the establishment of a greater number of minority-majority
- 7 districts or to otherwise enhance a minority group's opportunity
- 8 to elect the candidate of its choice. In calculating the number
- 9 of county, city, or township boundary breaks in a particular
- 10 redistricting plan, a boundary break pursuant to this subsection
- 11 shall not be counted as a county, city, or township boundary
- 12 break.
