THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 213 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1972, section 1 as amended by Act No. 464 of the Public
- 3 Acts of 1982, being sections 436.131 and 436.132 of the Michigan
- 4 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1. In addition to any and all taxes imposed by law,
