- 5 Sec. 1233b. (1) Except as provided in subsection -(3) (4),

- 8 nonendorsed teacher QUALIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION to teach -a
- 9 course in computer science, a foreign language, mathematics,

- 1 biology, chemistry, engineering, physics, robotics, or any
- 2 combination of these subject areas in grades 9 through 12.
- 3 (2) Subject to subsection -(3) (4), a noncertificated, non-
- 4 endorsed teacher is qualified to teach pursuant to this section
- 5 if he or she meets all of the following minimum requirements:
- 6 (a) Possesses an earned bachelor's degree from an accredited
- 7 postsecondary institution.
- 8 (b) Has a major or a graduate degree in the field of spe-
- 9 cialization in which he or she will teach.
- 10 (c) If the teacher desires to teach for more than 1 year,
- 11 has passed both a basic skills examination and a subject area
