## SENATE BILL No. 704

February 4, 1992, Introduced by Senators DI NELLO, BARCIA and WELBORN and referred to the Committee on State Affairs and Military/Veteran Affairs.

A bill to amend sections 3, 5, and 7 of Act No. 234 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled

"Michigan Vietnam veterans memorial act,"

being sections 35.1053, 35.1055, and 35.1057 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 3, 5, and 7 of Act No. 234 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1988, being sections 35.1053, 35.1055, and 35.1057
- 3 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3. The Vietnam veterans memorial monument fund is cre-
- 5 ated as a separate fund in the department of treasury. The state
- 6 treasurer shall seek appropriate federal tax status FOR THE MONU-
- 7 MENT FUND. The state treasurer shall credit to the monument fund
- 8 the money appropriated to the monument fund, -and- money received

- 1 for the monument fund under section 6, AND ALL INTEREST THAT
- 2 ACCRUES ON MONEY IN THE MONUMENT FUND.
- 3 Sec. 5. (1) The commission MAY USE MONEY IN THE MONUMENT
- 4 FUND FOR PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT AND shall oversee the
- 5 financing and construction of a VIETNAM VETERANS memorial monu-
- 6 ment dedicated to Vietnam veterans from Michigan who died or are
- 7 listed as missing in action as a result of the Vietnam conflict.
- 8 The commission shall solicit designs for the monument and shall
- 9 select the final design.
- 10 (2) The names of each Michigan Vietnam veteran who died or
- 11 is listed as missing in action as a result of the Vietnam con-
- 12 flict shall be inscribed on the VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL
- 13 monument.
- 14 (3) The VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL monument shall be located
- 15 on state-owned land -in-the capital city THAT MEETS BOTH OF THE
- 16 FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 17 (A) IS LOCATED IN DOWNTOWN LANSING AND BOUNDED BY OTTAWA
- 18 STREET ON THE NORTH, ALLEGAN STREET ON THE SOUTH, THE VACATED
- 19 PORTION OF SYCAMORE STREET THAT IS LOCATED BETWEEN OTTAWA AND
- 20 ALLEGAN STREETS ON THE EAST, AND LOGAN STREET ON THE WEST.
- 21 (B) CONSISTS OF NOT MORE THAN 2 ACRES WITHIN THAT PORTION OF
- 22 THE LAND DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A) THAT IS DIRECTLY WEST OF
- 23 THE PEAK OF THE CAPITOL DOME.
- 24 (4) UPON GROUNDBREAKING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE VIETNAM
- 25 VETERANS MEMORIAL MONUMENT, THE LAND DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (3)
- 26 SHALL BE DEDICATED AS A MEMORIAL PARK AND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR
- 27 THE CONSTRUCTION OF MEMORIAL MONUMENTS DEDICATED TO VETERANS WHO

- 1 SERVED IN A WAR OR CONFLICT IN WHICH THE UNITED STATES HAS BEEN
- 2 OR IS A PARTICIPANT AS DEFINED IN TITLE 38 OF THE UNITED STATES
- 3 CODE, 38 U.S.C. 101 TO 8528.
- 4 (5) THE MEMORIAL PARK DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (4) SHALL BE
- 5 LANDSCAPED IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER AND SHALL CONTAIN PARKING
- 6 FACILITIES TO ACCOMMODATE ONLY MEMORIAL PARK VISITORS.
- 7 Sec. 7. After the completion of construction of the monu-
- 8 ment pursuant to section 5 and payment of all amounts due in con-
- 9 nection with the monument, the commission is dissolved. The
- 10 state treasurer shall credit the department of management and
- 11 budget with any balance remaining in the monument fund. Money
- 12 credited to the department of management and budget shall be used
- 13 for the purpose of construction or maintenance of -other ALL
- 14 veterans' monuments IN THIS STATE.
