

SENATE BILL No. 722

February 13, 1992, Introduced by Senators MC MANUS, GAST and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of agriculture
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992, from the following funds:

11 GENERAL SECTIONS

12 Sec. 201. (1) In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
13 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in
14 this appropriation act is \$1,136,300.00 and state appropriations to be
15 paid to local units of government in section 101 are as follows:

17 (2) When it appears to the principal executive officer of each
18 department that state spending to local units of government will be less
19 than the amount that was projected to be expended for any quarter, the
20 principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the appro-
21 priate shortfall to the department of management and budget, the senate
22 and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house fiscal
23 agencies.

24 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under
25 this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and

1 programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to
2 the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984,
3 being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

4 Sec. 301. The \$1,136,300.00 appropriated in section 101 for grants
5 to local soil conservation districts shall be used for providing finan-
6 cial assistance to all soil conservation districts in order to permit the
7 districts to engage in programs that conserve soil resources and prevent
8 and control soil erosion. All grants to local soil conservation dis-
9 tricts shall be allocated according to a formula approved by the commis-
10 sion of agriculture.
