SENATE BILL No. 726

February 19, 1992, Introduced by Senators HONIGMAN and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Development.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 120 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended

"An act to authorize the redevelopment of principal shopping areas of certain cities; to permit the creation of certain boards; and to authorize the collection of revenue and the bonding of certain cities for such redevelopment projects,"

as amended by Act No. 260 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 125.981 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 7.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 120 of the Public Acts of

- 19 CAMPS; CAMPGROUNDS; ZOOLOGICAL AND BOTANICAL GARDENS; SWIMMING,
- 20 BOATING, HUNTING, FISHING, AND BIRDING AREAS; AND FOOT, BICYCLE,
- 21 AND BRIDLE PATHS.
- 22 (B) OPEN OR SCENIC SPACE.
- 23 (C) ENVIRONMENTAL, CONSERVATION, NATURE, OR WILDLIFE AREAS.
