February 19, 1992, Introduced by Senators HONIGMAN and EHLERS and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Development.

A bill to amend sections 1, 2, 4, and 15 of Act No. 312 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled as amended
"The metropolitan district act,"
being sections 119.1, 119.2, 119.4, and 119.15 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1, 2, 4, and 15 of Act No. 312 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1929, being sections 119.1, 119.2, 119.4, and
- 3 119.15 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 1. Any COMBINATION OF 2 or more cities; villages;
- 6 -or townships; -or any combination or parts -thereof OF
- 7 CITIES, VILLAGES, OR TOWNSHIPS, may incorporate into a
- 8 metropolitan district or districts comprising territory within
- 9 their -respective limits for the purpose of acquiring, owning,

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- 1 PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, operating, and maintaining either
- 2 within or without their limits -, as may be established
- 3 hereunder, parks; PARKING FACILITIES; or public utilities for
- 4 supplying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or transportation.
- 5 or any combination thereof. Each organized A PUBLIC UTILITY
- 6 FOR SUPPLYING TRANSPORTATION INCLUDES A RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM THAT
- 7 MAY CONSIST OF A TUNNEL, SUBWAY, SURFACE, OR ELEVATED SYSTEM. A
- 8 district -hereunder-shall be CREATED UNDER THIS ACT IS a body
- 9 corporate.
- 10 Sec. 2. Any A district incorporated under this act -shall
- 11 have the power to MAY acquire, own, PURCHASE, CONSTRUCT, oper-
- 12 ate, and maintain, within or without its limits, parks; PARKING
- 13 FACILITIES; or public utilities for supplying sewage disposal,
- 14 drainage, water, or transportation or any combination thereof or
- 15 MAY EXERCISE such of -said THESE powers -as may be THAT ARE
- 16 designated in its charter. -Any such- A district may sell or
- 17 purchase, either within or without its limits, sewage disposal or
- 18 drainage rights OR water or transportation facilities or any
- 19 combination thereof if so provided by its charter. Any such A
- 20 district shall have the power to MAY acquire and succeed to
- 21 -any or all of the rights, obligations, and property of -any A
- 22 city; -, village; -or township; -, or -any parts thereof,
- 23 PART OF A CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP comprising territory within

- 4 Sec. 4. Each district incorporated under the provisions
- 5 -hereof OF THIS ACT may provide FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING
- 6 in its charter:
- 7 (a) For annually ANNUALLY laying and collecting taxes in a
- 8 sum not to exceed 1/2% of 1 per centum of the assessed value of
- 9 all real and personal property in the district.
- 10 (b) For borrowing BORROWING money on the credit of the
- 11 district in a sum not to exceed 2% -per centum- of the assessed
- 12 value of all real and personal property in the district for the
- 13 purpose of acquiring, owning, purchasing, constructing, maintain-
- 14 ing, or operating parks; PARKING FACILITIES; or public utilities
- 15 for supplying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or
- 16 transportation. -, or any combination thereof: Provided, That
- 17 any such FOR THESE PURPOSES, A district may borrow money and
- 18 issue bonds -for any of the above purposes or any combination
- 19 thereof which will- THAT impose no liability upon the district
- 20 -but which AND may be paid and ARE secured only by special
- 21 -assessment levied against each parcel for the particular public
- 22 improvement herein provided for and for the payment of which
- 23 bonds are issued: Provided further, That any ASSESSMENTS. A
- 24 district -incorporated under the provisions hereof, may, for the
- 25 purpose of acquiring, owning, purchasing, constructing, or oper-
- 26 ating -any A SEWAGE DISPOSAL, DRAINAGE, WATER, OR TRANSPORTATION
- 27 public utility, -herein provided for, issue mortgage bonds

- 1 -therefor, or any combination thereof, which said mortgage bonds
- 2 may be issued beyond the general limit of bonded indebtedness
- 3 prescribed by this act. -: Provided, That such mortgage bonds-
- 4 A MORTGAGE BOND issued beyond the general limits of bonded
- 5 indebtedness shall not impose -any liability upon the district
- 6 but shall be secured only upon the property and revenues of
- 7 such THE public utility, including the franchise. -, stating
- 8 THE MORTGAGE BOND SHALL STATE the terms upon which, in case of
- 9 foreclosure, the purchaser may operate the -same- PUBLIC UTILITY,
- 10 which franchise shall -in no case NOT extend for a longer period
- 11 than 20 years from the date of -such THE sale of -such THE
- 12 utility and franchise on foreclosure. -: And provided, That
- 13 said THE mortgage bond shall be sold for not less than par
- 14 AND bear interest at a rate not in excess of 6%, per centum,
- 15 and the total amount -thereof- OF THE MORTGAGE BONDS shall not
- 16 exceed 60% -per centum of the original cost of the utility. -:
- 17 And provided further, That the THE charter of any such A dis-
- 18 trict ISSUING MORTGAGE BONDS shall provide for the creation of a
- 19 sinking fund by setting aside -such A percentage of the gross or
- 20 net earnings of the public utility as may be deemed sufficient
- 21 for the payment of the mortgage bonds at maturity.
- 22 (c) For a lien LIENS on any property and for
- 23 the payment of -any- bonds issued or for the cost and expense of
- 24 making any improvement herein provided for IMPROVEMENTS MADE
- 25 PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.
- 26 (d) For laying LAYING and collecting rents, tolls, and
- 27 excises.

- 1 (e) -For a A special assessment district to -provide for-
- 2 RECOVER the cost -and expense of -any- ACQUIRING, OWNING, PUR-
- 3 CHASING, CONSTRUCTING, OPERATING, OR MAINTAINING A park, PARKING
- 4 FACILITY, or public utility -, or combination thereof, herein
- 5 provided for PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.
- 6 (f) -For-the- THE purchase or condemnation of the fran-
- 7 chises, if any exist, and -of the- property used in the operation
- 8 of companies or individuals engaged in or operating public
- 9 utilities for supplying sewage disposal, drainage, water, or
- 10 transportation. -, or any combination thereof. And each A dis-
- 11 trict may in its charter provide that it may make a contract,
- 12 upon -such terms -, including terms of present or deferred pay-
- 13 ment and upon such conditions and in such manner as THAT the
- 14 district -may deem CONSIDERS proper, to purchase, operate, and
- 15 maintain —any— existing public utility property for supplying
- 16 sewage disposal, drainage, water, or transportation -, or any
- 17 combination thereof within or without its limits. if IF THE
- 18 UTILITY PROPERTY IS FOR SUPPLYING SERVICE without -its THE
- 19 DISTRICT'S limits, then -such THE purchase -must OF THE UTILITY
- 20 PROPERTY SHALL be incidental to the operation and maintenance of
- 21 -such THE public utility. No such SUCH A contract -shall-
- 22 DOES NOT bind the district unless the proposition -therefor shall
- 23 receive TO ENTER THE CONTRACT RECEIVES the affirmative vote of
- 24 3/5 of the electors voting -thereon- ON THE PROPOSITION at a reg-
- 25 ular or special election. In the event of any such IF A pur-
- 26 chase IS MADE, the charter -amendment- and the contract to
- 27 purchase shall provide for the creation of a sinking fund, into

- 1 which shall be paid from time to time, from the earnings of the
- 2 utility, sums sufficient to -insure- ENSURE the payment of the
- 3 purchase price and the performance of the obligations of -said-
- 4 THE contract -to the end SO that the entire cost of -such THE
- 5 public utility shall eventually be paid from its earnings. The
- 6 powers CONTAINED in this subdivision -contained shall be ARE in
- 7 addition to the OTHER powers provided for in the other subdivi-
- 8 sions of this act. -and particularly this section, and the
- 9 exercise thereof shall not impair or affect the right to exercise
- 10 any of the powers in the other subdivisions of this section
- 11 conferred.
- 12 (g) For the THE ACQUISITION, BY purchase, gift, or condem-
- 13 nation, of private property for -any public use or- A purpose
- 14 herein provided for IN THIS ACT and within the scope of its
- 15 THE DISTRICT'S power. If THE PROPERTY IS TO BE ACQUIRED by con-
- 16 demnation, the provisions of Act NO. 149 of the Public Acts of
- 17 Michigan, approved March twenty fifth, 1911, entitled "An act to
- 18 provide for the condemnation by state agencies and public corpo-
- 19 rations of private property for the use or benefit of the public,
- 20 and to define the terms 'public corporations', 'state agencies'
- 21 and 'private property' as used herein", or such other appropriate
- 22 provisions therefor as exist or shall be made by law may be
- 23 adopted, and 1911, BEING SECTIONS 213.21 TO 213.25 OF THE
- 24 MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, AND THE UNIFORM CONDEMNATION PROCEDURES
- 25 ACT, ACT NO. 87 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1980, BEING SECTIONS 213.51
- 26 TO 213.77 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, MAY BE used for the

- 1 purpose of instituting and prosecuting -such THE condemnation
 2 proceedings.
- 3 (h) -For the- THE initiative and referendum on -all- matters
- 4 within the scope of -its- THE DISTRICT'S powers and -for- the
- 5 recall of -all its- THE DISTRICT'S officials.
- (i) For altering ALTERING, amending, or repealing any A
 7 charter affecting the district.
- 8 (j) -For the THE enforcement of -all such local, police,
- 9 sanitary, and other regulations -as THAT are not in conflict
- 10 with general laws.
- 11 (k) For a A system of civil service.
- 12 (1) For the THE exercise of all district powers in the
- 13 management and control of district property and in the adminis-
- 14 tration of -metropolitan district government, whether -such THE
- 15 powers -be- ARE expressly enumerated or not; -for- any act to
- 16 advance the interest, -of the district, the- good government, and
- 17 prosperity of the district; and -to-pass all THE PASSAGE OF laws
- 18 and ordinances relating to its concerns subject to the constitu-
- 19 tion and general laws of the state. Provided, That the power
- 20 to acquire a rapid transit system is expressly conferred by this
- 21 act which may consist of a tunnel, subway, surface or elevated
- 22 system or any combination thereof and said rapid transit system
- 23 shall be deemed to be transportation within the meaning of this
- 24 act and the provisions hereof relating to other public utilities
- 25 shall apply thereto.
- 26 Sec. 15. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 27 metropolitan district act. AS USED IN THIS ACT, "PARK" MEANS AN

- 1 AREA OF LAND OR WATER, OR BOTH, DEDICATED TO 1 OR MORE OF THE
- 2 FOLLOWING USES:
- 3 (A) RECREATIONAL PURPOSES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 4 LANDSCAPED TRACTS; PICNIC GROUNDS; PLAYGROUNDS; ATHLETIC FIELDS;
- 5 CAMPS; CAMPGROUNDS; ZOOLOGICAL AND BOTANICAL GARDENS; SWIMMING,
- 6 BOATING, HUNTING, FISHING, AND BIRDING AREAS; AND FOOT, BICYCLE,
- 7 AND BRIDLE PATHS.
- 8 (B) OPEN OR SCENIC SPACE.
- 9 (C) ENVIRONMENTAL, CONSERVATION, NATURE, OR WILDLIFE AREAS.

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
