

SENATE BILL No. 866

April 28, 1992, Introduced by Senators DILLINGHAM and
WARTNER and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend section 1284 of Act No. 451 of the Public
Acts of 1976, entitled as amended
"The school code of 1976,"
being section 380.1284 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1284 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
2 of 1976, being section 380.1284 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1284. (1) The board of a school district shall deter-
5 mine the length of the school term. The minimum number of days
6 of student instruction shall be 180. ~~—A—~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
7 SECTION 101 OF THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT OF 1979, BEING
8 SECTION 388.1701 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, A district
9 failing to hold 180 days of student instruction shall forfeit
10 1/180 of its total state school aid for each day of failure. Not

1 later than August 1, the board of each district shall certify to
2 the state board the number of days of student instruction in the
3 previous school year. If the district did not hold at least 180
4 days of student instruction, the deduction of state school aid
5 shall be made in the following fiscal year from the first payment
6 of state school aid. Days lost because of strikes or teachers'
7 conferences shall not be counted as days of student instruction.

8 (2) The state board shall promulgate rules for the implemen-
9 tation of this section.
