## AN ADDENDUM TO SENATE FISCAL AGENCY ANALYSIS DATED 3-8-94

The House Mental Health Committee adopted a substitute for Senate Bill 807 that differs from the Senate-passed version of the bill in the following ways:

- -- The bill would clarify that psychiatric partial hospitalization programs would provide treatment for both adults who have "mental illness" and minors having "emotional disturbance", as those terms are defined in the Mental Health Code.
- -- The bill would require the Department of Mental Health to issue a provisional license to an existing psychiatric partial hospitalization program that was operating under a certificate of need on the bill's effective date.
