A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4227 AS INTRODUCED 2-11-93

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to generally require the defense in a criminal case to disclose upon request of the prosecutor any of the following: the nature of any defense for which evidence is intended to be offered at trial; the names and addresses of planned defense witnesses, along with any documentation of statements they had made; any relevant statements of planned expert witnesses; and any materials intended to be introduced as evidence. However, the bill would not apply where supreme court rule provided otherwise.
