A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4339 AS INTRODUCED 2-23-93

The Michigan Vehicle Code currently allows a person who holds an operator's or chauffeur's license to place on the back of his or her driver's license certain medical information, such as the licensee's blood type, his or her immunization data, a statement that the licensee has made an anatomical gift pursuant to the Public Health Code, and the like. The bill would amend the act to also allow a licensee to place on the back of his or her driver's license a statement that the licensee had designated a patient advocate to make care, custody and medical treatment decisions for him or her pursuant to the Revised Probate Code. If a licensee placed such a statement on the back of his or her license, the patient advocate's name and two emergency telephone numbers where he or she could be reached could be placed there as well.
