A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4372 AS INTRODUCED 2-25-93

The bill would amend the Michigan Campaign Finance Act (Public Act 388 of 1976) to lower the contribution level, from \$200 to \$50, at which a contributor's occupation, employer, and principal place of business must be recorded. The bill also would change the requirement currently placed on a filing committee that requires its name, address, and telephone number, and the full name, residential and business addresses, and telephone numbers of its treasurer to instead require the full name, residential and business addresses, and telephone numbers of its treasurer or other individual designated as responsible for the committee's record keeping, report preparation, or report filing. Finally, the bill would change the amount at which the name and address of each individual contributor must be recorded from "\$20.01 or more" to "more than \$20."
