**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4482-4484 AS INTRODUCED 3-9-93**

The bills would provide for the election, rather than the appointment, of the state's insurance commissioner, beginning with the 1994 election. Generally speaking, the insurance commissioner would be treated like the attorney general and secretary of state: nominated by a political party at the fall state convention to run in the general election as a statewide candidate for a four-year term. House Bill 4482 would amend the Insurance Code (MCL 500.202 and 500.204). House Bill 4483 would amend the Michigan Election Law (MCL 168.71 et al.) House Bill 4484 would amend the campaign finance act (MCL 169.212) to include the insurance commissioner under the term "state elective office." The bills are tie-barred to one another.
