A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4487 AS INTRODUCED 3-11-93

The bill would amend the Michigan Liquor Control Act to require the Liquor Control Commission to maintain a system for the distribution of spirits involving at least 75 distribution facilities in substantially the same size and in the same locations as in existence on January 1, 1992. (The term "distribution facility" would refer to a store, warehouse, or any similar facility used in the distribution of spirits. The term "spirits" is used in the act in contrast to the terms "beer" and "wine", although wines of over 21 percent alcohol content, other than sacramental wines, are included as spirits.)
