A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4619 AS INTRODUCED 4-20-93

The Michigan Vehicle Code at present requires a court to impound the vehicle of someone caught driving while his or her license is suspended, revoked, or denied, providing the driver was at least part owner in the vehicle; the impoundment is for 30 to 120 days. Under the bill, if the underlying license action was a suspension for failing to answer a citation or comply with a civil infraction order or judgment, impoundment would not be mandated, but rather would be at the option of the court. The bill also would eliminate consideration of whether the driver was an owner of the vehicle.
