A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4629 AS INTRODUCED 4-21-93

Public Act 471 of 1988 amended the Public Health Code to require that people convicted of certain crimes (those involving sexual conduct with sexual penetration or those involving the intravenous use of illegal drugs) be tested for the presence of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). With the victim's consent, he or she is given the test results.

The bill would amend the Public Health Code to allow the victim's parent, guardian, or person in loco parentis to consent to receiving the HIV test results in those cases where the victim (or "person with whom the defendant engaged in sexual penetration") was a minor or otherwise incapacitated.
