A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4633 AS INTRODUCED 4-21-93

The Michigan Legislative Retirement System Act currently allows the legislative retirement board to purchase and pay premiums on dental, hospital and medical coverage insurance for retirants and deferred vested members, and for their spouses, eligible children and survivors, from appropriations made for this purpose to the grants and insurance revolving fund. The bill would amend the act to prohibit the board from purchasing or paying the premiums on any long-term health care and nursing home insurance for those eligible for retirement benefits. In addition, the board would have to cancel any long-term health care and nursing home insurance that it had authorized and purchased after December 1, 1992.
