A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4642 AS INTRODUCED 4-23-93

The Worker's Disability Compensation Act generally requires all employers to purchase worker's compensation disability insurance for their employees either through the State Accident Fund or from a private insurer, or to be self-insured. The act currently provides that, under procedures and conditions determined by the director of the Department of Labor, a separate insurance policy may be issued to cover employers performing work at a specified construction site if certain criteria are met, including that the cost of construction at the site will exceed \$100 million. The bill would lower this threshold to \$35 million.
