A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4685 AS INTRODUCED 5-4-93

Public Act 62 of 1956 allows a municipality to adopt the Michigan Uniform Traffic Code to provide for the regulation of vehicles within its borders. The bill would amend the act to provide that, notwithstanding the requirements of the uniform traffic code, a handicapped parking sign would have to 1) be 12 inches by 18 inches or larger, 2) be either blue or white, and 3) at a minimum contain the international handicapped symbol in contrasting colors of either blue or white in the sign's center.
