A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4730 AS INTRODUCED 5-6-93

The Michigan Liquor Control Act requires the Liquor Control Commission to establish uniform retail prices for the sale of alcoholic liquor in state liquor stores and by businesses licensed to sell bottled liquor at the retail level ("specially designated distributors," or SDD's). Those prices are to reflect a state markup of between 51 and 65 percent. The bill would instead limit the state markup to a maximum of 51 percent.
