A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4734 AS INTRODUCED 5-6-93

The Public Health Code requires that people charged with or convicted of certain prostitution- or intravenous drug-related crimes be tested for the so-called "AIDS virus," human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), and that the victims of such crimes be notified of the test results should they so desire.

The bill would extend these testing requirements to juveniles determined by the juvenile court to have committed first degree criminal sexual assault, and would require that their victims also be notified of the test results if they so desired.
