A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4767 AS INTRODUCED 5-11-93

The bill would amend the litter law, Public Act 106 of 1963, to require a litterer to be fined at least \$100, increase the maximum fine from \$400 to \$500, delete a provision for jail time, and require the court to order community service in the form of litter-gathering labor. (Community service is now at the discretion of the court; if community service is ordered, it must be in lieu of any other punishment. The bill not only would mandate community service, but impose it in addition to the newly-mandated fine.)
