**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4802 AS INTRODUCED 5-19-93**

The bill would amend the no-fault automobile insurance sections of the Insurance Code to prohibit insurance companies from refusing to issue an insurance policy or from imposing a premium surcharge on the private automobile of a peace officer, fire fighter, or ambulance driver based on accident rate statistics compiled while driving in the pursuit of his or her duties. (For a peace officer, the bill refers to driving any vehicle in the pursuit of his or her duties; for a fire fighter or ambulance driver, the reference is to a fire department vehicle or licensed ambulance.)
