SCHOOL SMOKING EXCEPTIONS

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5026 AS INTRODUCED 9-15-93

Public Act 140 of 1993 (Senate Bill 459), generally speaking, prohibits the use of tobacco products on public school property. The prohibition does not apply, however, to outdoor areas (including, but not limited to, open-air stadiums) during certain time periods: after 6 p.m. on school days or at any time on Saturdays, Sundays, and days on which there are no regularly scheduled school hours. That act was an amendment to the Michigan Penal Code.

House Bill 5026 would expand the exception by providing that during the times referred to above, the tobacco prohibition would not apply to any school property used for a fund-raising activity approved by the governing board of the school district.
