A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5032 AS INTRODUCED 9-21-93

Public Act 210 of 1945 entitles a prisoner in a county jail to a good time sentence reduction of one day for each six days of sentence, providing the prisoner's record shows no violations of rules and regulations. The bill would allow additional sentence reductions of one day for every two days of community service performed, or one day for every two days of serving as a trustee in jail. Any additional reductions to be awarded under the bill would have to be approved by the sentencing judge (or his or her successor) as well as the sheriff.
