A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5130 AS INTRODUCED 10-14-93

The bill would amend the District Library Establishment Act to provide that the maximum districtwide tax would be four mills. Currently, a districtwide tax cannot exceed two mills, except that if one or more of the participating municipalities had a legally established public library with an authorized tax levy of more than two mills when the act took effect (May 21, 1989), the district library could levy the greatest number of mills authorized to be levied. (A districtwide tax must be approved by voters.)
