ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4103

AN ACT to amend section 7212 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "An act to protect and promote the public health; to codify, revise, consolidate, classify, and add to the laws relating to public health; to provide for the prevention and control of diseases and disabilities; to provide for the classification, administration, regulation, financing, and maintenance of personal, environmental, and other health services and activities; to create or continue, and prescribe the powers and duties of, departments, boards, commissions, councils, committees, task forces, and other agencies; to prescribe the powers and duties of governmental entities and officials; to regulate occupations, facilities, and agencies affecting the public health; to regulate health maintenance organizations and certain third party administrators and insurers; to promote the efficient and economical delivery of health care services, to provide for the appropriate utilization of health care facilities and services, and to provide for the closure of hospitals or consolidation of hospitals or services; to provide for the collection and use of data and information; to provide for the transfer of property; to provide certain immunity from liability; to regulate and prohibit the sale and offering for sale of drug paraphernalia under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts; to repeal certain parts of this act; and to repeal certain parts of this act on specific dates," as amended by Act No. 352 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 333.7212 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 7212 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended by Act No. 352 of the Public Acts of 1982, being section 333.7212 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7212. (1) The following controlled substances are included in schedule 1:
