AN ACT to repeal sections 267, 268, 269, and 270 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended "An act to revise, consolidate, codify and add to the statutes relating to crimes; to define crimes and prescribe the penalties therefor; to provide for restitution under certain circumstances; to provide for the competency of evidence at the trial of persons accused of crime; to provide immunity from prosecution for certain witnesses appearing at such trials; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with or contravening any of the provisions of this act," being sections 750.267, 750.268, 750.269, and 750.270 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Sections 267, 268, 269, and 270 of Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, being sections 750.267, 750.268, 750.269, and 750.270 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are repealed.
