ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 773

AN ACT to amend Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931 entitled as amended An act to revise consolidate codify and add to the statutes relating to crimes to define crimes and prescribe the penalties therefor to provide for restitution under certain circumstances to provide for the competency of evidence at the trial of persons accused of crime to provide immunity from prosecution for certain witnesses appearing at such trials and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts inconsistent with or contravening any of the provisions of this act as amended being sections 750 1 to 750 568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws by adding section 529a

The People of the State of Michigan enact.

Section 1 Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931 as amended being sections 750 1 to 750 568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws is amended by adding section 529a to read as follows

Sec 529a (1) A person who by force or violence or by threat of force or violence or by putting in fear robs steals or takes a motor vehicle as defined in section 412 from another person in the presence of that person or the presence of a passenger or in the presence of any other person in lawful possession of the motor vehicle is guilty of carjacking a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or for any term of years

(2) A sentence imposed for a violation of this section may be imposed to run consecutively to any other sentence imposed for a conviction that arises out of the same transaction

Section 2 This amendatory act shall take effect October 1 1994

This act is ordered to take immediate effect
