AN ACT to amend Act No 269 of the Public Acts of 1989 entitled An act to provide civil immunity to persons who operate or use certain sport shooting ranges and to regulate the application of state and local laws rules regulations and ordinances regarding sport shooting ranges being sections 691 1541 to 691 1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws by adding section 4

The People of the State of Michigan enact

Section 1 Act No 269 of the Public Acts of 1989 being sections 691 1541 to 691 1543 of the Michigan Compiled Laws is amended by adding section 4 to read as follows

Sec 4 Each person who participates in sport shooting at a sport shooting range that conforms to generally accepted operation practices accepts the risks associated with the sport to the extent the risks are obvious and inherent. Those risks include but are not limited to injuries that may result from noise discharge of a projectile or shot malfunction of sport shooting equipment not owned by the shooting range natural variations in terrain surface or subsurface snow or ice conditions bare spots rocks trees and other forms of natural growth or debris

Section 2 This amendatory act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill No 788 of the 87th Legislature is enacted into law
