AN ACT to repeal sections 751, 752, 753, 754, 755, and 756 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended "An act to provide a system of public instruction and elementary and secondary schools; to revise, consolidate, and classify the laws relating to elementary and secondary education; to provide for the classification, organization, regulation, and maintenance of schools, school districts, and intermediate school districts; to prescribe rights, powers, duties, and privileges of schools, school districts, and intermediate school districts; to provide for the regulation of school teachers and school administrators; to provide for school elections and to prescribe powers and duties with respect thereto; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes; to provide for the borrowing of money and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness; to establish a fund and provide for expenditures from that fund; to provide for and prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments, the state board of education, and certain other boards and officials; to provide for licensure of boarding schools; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," being sections 380.751, 380.753, 380.753, 380.754, 380.755, and 380.756 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Sections 751, 752, 753, 754, 755, and 756 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 380.751, 380.752, 380.753, 380.754, 380.755, and 380.756 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are repealed.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
