



HOUSE BILL No. 4039

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend sections 3, 43, and 51 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended

"State license fee act,"

section 3 as amended by Act No. 268 of the Public Acts of 1990 and sections 43 and 51 as amended by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 338.2203, 338.2243, and 338.2251 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Sections 3, 43, and 51 of Act No. 152 of the
2 Public Acts of 1979, section 3 as amended by Act No. 268 of the
3 Public Acts of 1990 and sections 43 and 51 as amended by Act
4 No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 338.2203,
5 338.2243, and 338.2251 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended
6 to read as follows:

1 Sec. 3. (1) The fees prescribed by this act shall be used
2 only to offset the cost of operating the department.

3 (2) Except as otherwise provided in ~~sections 37 and 38~~
4 THIS ACT, the fees collected pursuant to this act shall be cred-
5 ited to the general fund of the state.

6 Sec. 43. (1) Fees for a person licensed or seeking licen-
7 sure to engage in the practice of mortuary science or to operate
8 a funeral establishment or for a person licensed or seeking
9 licensure as a resident trainee, or licensed as an embalmer or
10 funeral director under article 18 of the occupational code, being
11 sections 339.1801 to 339.1812 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are
12 as follows:

13 (a) Application processing fees:

14 (i) Mortuary science license.....\$ 20.00

15 (ii) Funeral establishment license..... 115.00

16 (iii) Resident trainee..... 15.00

17 (b) Examination fees:

18 (i) Complete examination..... 200.00

19 (ii) National examination only..... 150.00

20 (iii) State examination only..... 50.00

21 (c) Examination review..... 25.00

22 (d) License fees, per year:

23 (i) Mortuary science..... ~~30.00~~ 45.00

24 (ii) Funeral establishment..... 55.00

25 (iii) Embalmer..... 30.00

(v) Resident trainee..... 15.00

(2) THE MORTUARY SCIENCE EDUCATION FUND IS ESTABLISHED IN THE STATE TREASURY AND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT. TEN DOLLARS OF EACH LICENSE FEE RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(D)(i) SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITH THE STATE TREASURER TO THE CREDIT OF THE MORTUARY SCIENCE EDUCATION FUND. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL UTILIZE THE MORTUARY SCIENCE EDUCATION FUND ONLY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED UPON HOLDERS OF A LICENSE FOR THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY SCIENCE UNDER SECTION 1806A OF THE OCCUPATIONAL CODE, BEING SECTION 339.1806A OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS. ANY UNEXPENDED BALANCE IN THE MORTUARY SCIENCE EDUCATION FUND AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR SHALL CARRY FORWARD TO THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR AND SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

Sec. 51. (1) Until September 30, 1993, fees for a person licensed or seeking licensure to engage in the ~~manufacture, distribution~~ MANUFACTURING, DISTRIBUTING, prescribing, ~~or~~ dispensing, ~~of~~ OR CONDUCTING RESEARCH WITH controlled substances under part 73 of the public health code, are as follows:
