

HOUSE BILL No. 4040

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to allow the secretary of state to accept credit card payments in certain financial transactions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. The secretary of state may accept a credit card, in 2 lieu of cash, check, or money order, as payment of a tax, fee, 3 price, or charge required under any act or rule promulgated under 4 the authority of an act administered by the secretary of state or 5 under which the secretary of state is responsible for collecting 6 a tax, fee, price, or charge. The secretary of state shall 7 determine which major credit cards may be accepted for payment 8 under those acts.
