

HOUSE BILL No. 4046

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to provide for a picture on an identification card of individuals holding certain occupational licenses under certain circumstances; and to provide for certain powers and duties for certain state agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "License" means a certificate, registration, or license
- 3 issued by an occupational regulatory agency which allows an indi-
- 4 vidual to engage in a regulated occupation or which allows an
- 5 individual to use a specific title in the practice of an occupa-
- 6 tion, profession, or vocation.
- (b) "Occupational regulatory agency" means a department,
- 8 bureau, or agency of the state of Michigan that has regulatory
- 9 authority over a regulated occupation.

- 1 (c) "Regulated occupation" means an occupation, profession,
- 2 or vocation which requires a license as a predicate for the
- 3 practice of the occupation, profession, or vocation or for the
- 4 use of a specific title in the practice of the occupation, pro-
- 5 fession, or vocation.
- 6 Sec. 2. An occupational regulatory agency which issues an
- 7 identification card to an individual holding a license for a req-
- 8 ulated occupation shall provide for a picture of the licensed
- 9 individual on the identification card.
