

HOUSE BILL No. 4050

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 23 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended

"McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act," being section 432.23 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 23 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 2 1972, being section 432.23 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 23. (1) A THE COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT ISSUE A license
- 5 as an agent to sell lottery tickets or shares -shall not be
- 6 issued to any person to engage in business exclusively as a lot-
- 7 tery sales agent. Before issuing a license, the commissioner
- 8 shall consider factors such as the financial responsibility and
- 9 security of the person and his OR HER business or activity, the
- 10 accessibility of his OR HER place of business or activity to the

- 1 public, the sufficiency of existing licenses to serve the public
- 2 convenience, and the volume of expected sales.
- 3 (2) As used in this section "person" means an individual,
- 4 association, corporation, club, trust, estate, society, company.
- 5 joint stock company, receiver, trustee, referee, any other person
- 6 acting in a fiduciary or representative capacity who is appointed
- 7 by a court, or any combination of individuals. Person includes
- 8 any department, commission, agency or instrumentality of the
- 9 state, including any county, city, village or township and any
- 10 agency or instrumentality thereof.
- 11 (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person
- 12 licensed pursuant to this act may act as a lottery sales agent.
- 13 -A THE COMMISSIONER MAY LICENSE AS A LOTTERY SALES AGENT A
- 14 person lawfully engaged in nongovernmental business on state
- 15 property. -may be licensed as a lottery sales agent.
- 16 (4) A license is not assignable or transferable.
- (5) A licensed agent or his OR HER employee may sell lottery
- 18 tickets or shares only on the premises stated in the license of
- 19 the agent.
- 20 (6) The commissioner may issue temporary licenses upon con-
- 21 ditions as he deems necessary for a term which shall not extend
- 22 beyond 1 year after the effective date of this act.
- 23 (6) $\frac{(7)}{(7)}$ The commissioner may require a bond from any
- 24 licensed agent in an amount as provided in the rules PROMULGATED
- 25 PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.

- (7) -(8) A licensed agent shall display his OR HER license 2 or a copy thereof OF THE LICENSE conspicuously in accordance 3 with the rules PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT.
- (8) (9) The commissioner may suspend or revoke the license of any agent who violates this act or a rule promulgated pursuant to this act. THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE COMMISSIONER SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHAPTER 4 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, ACT NO. 306 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1969, BEING SECTIONS 24.271 TO 24.287 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
