



HOUSE BILL No. 4054

February 2, 1993, Introduced by Rep. Joe Young, Jr. and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the protection and conservation of the natural resources of the state; to provide and develop facilities for outdoor recreation; to create a conservation department; to define the powers and duties thereof; to provide rules and regulations concerning the use and occupancy of lands and property under its control and penalties for the violation thereof; to provide for the transfer to said department of the powers and duties now vested by law in certain boards, commissions and officers of the state; and for the abolishing of the boards, commissions and offices the powers and duties of which are hereby transferred,"

as amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 10a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1921, as
2 amended, being sections 299.1 to 299.10 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 10a to read as follows:

1 SEC. 10A. THE COMMISSION OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL
2 ESTABLISH IN THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES A RECREATIONAL
3 PROGRAM FOR MINORS. THE PROGRAM SHALL FOCUS ON EXPANDING THE
4 PARTICIPANT'S APPRECIATION AND KNOWLEDGE OF ISSUES PERTAINING TO
5 NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION WITHIN THIS STATE.
